ALL CONTESTANTS MUST BE 16 YEARS OF AGE OR OLDER

RULES FOR SLAB CUTTING COMPETITION

Chain saw must be stock model, no <u>engine</u> modifications, and <u>MUST</u> have all original safety equipment in place; contestants <u>MUST</u> wear approved safety glasses (not provided) Lowest time wins

RULES FOR FIREWOOD SPLITTING COMPETITION

A round will be chosen randomly and each contestant will split their round into pieces small enough to go through a 6"hole that is cut into a piece of plywood. All pieces of the round must be put through the hole and the time ends when the last piece is through the hole.

RULES FOR AXE THROWING COMPETITION

Each competitor will receive THREE throws, plus 1 practice throw at the beginning to sight the target. Most points at the end of THREE throws wins.

RULES FOR AXE CHOPPING COMPETITION

Each competitor will receive an approx. 8" round that is affixed to a steel holder in the ground. The round must be cut completely through using the single blade axes provided by Frontier Days. Lowest time wins.

Woodcutter's Jamboree Axe Throwing Rules

DETAILED RULES FOR AXE THROWING COMPETION

The bull's eye shall score 5 points, the next outside area 4 points, the next outer 3 points, next 2 points and the next 1 point

- 1. Final resting place of axe is scoring area. Points will be scored in the highest point ring in which the axe is resting. If both points stick there will be no points given for that throw. The axes must stick in the target until the judge removes or instructs the contestant to do so.
- 2. Contestant must stand behind a foul line. Axe must be released before either foot crosses the foul line. This rule will be enforced.
- 3. The axe must be double bitted of at least 2-1/2 pounds having an overall length of no less than 24 inches and no greater than 40 inches as measured from the top of the eye to the end of the handle. The blade width will not exceed 6 inches.
- 4. The leading edge of the axe shall be the scoring edge.
- 5. One practice throw and 5 throws for score. If contestant does not wish a practice throw it is his responsibility to inform the judge before starting his 1st throw.
- 6. After throw has been scored the score cannot be changed for any reason.
