MOWER CLASSES ~ ZERO TURN MOWERS ARE NOT ALLOWED IN ANY CLASS

Stock #1 - ONE LUNG 17HP Max

Stock #2 - TWO LUNG 22HP Max

- 1) All Mowers must have a mower deck - **Blades must be removed from mower decks,** mower deck does not have to be operable.
- 2) **Totally stock frame, chassis, suspension, tires, wheels and steering required.** Reinforcement to the frame is allowed.
- 3) Engine must be **stock** type (ie:) Kohler, Briggs or Tecumseh, etc.
- 4) May re-route exhaust pipe, but must terminate away from the driver and competitors, in a rearward and downward direction, without creating a safety hazard.
No internal modifications to the engine..
- 5) **Gear ratios and pulleys may NOT be changed. Must have lawn mower transmission or transaxle.**

Modified - (UP TO 20HP MAXIMUM)

- 1) **Stock frame & chassis, MUST INCLUDE STANDARD MOWER DECK (no blades)** - Cutting decks must be securely mounted in near stock location.
- 2) May re-route exhaust pipe, but must terminate away from the driver and competitors, in a rearward and downward direction, without creating a safety hazard.
- 3) May change to centrifugal clutch
- 4) Motor position may be changed
- 5) Steering arms and tie rods may be strengthened
- 6) Brakes are legal, but not mandatory.

Drag Mowers

Fenders and body panels are not mandatory

Modifications allowed: Engine Placement, carburetor, exhaust, centrifugal clutch. Chassis modifications are OK if safe and pass inspection. Tires & Wheels. Mower deck may be a facsimile of a mower deck, placed under the chassis (NO BLADES);

Power Wheels class—Open to all child sized battery operated “vehicles”

This class is for children **5 years of age and up**. A parent **MUST** be present whenever the child is on the track. The driver (child) must be able to reach and operate ALL of the controls. Safety is of the upmost importance in this class. All drivers must demonstrate that they can safely drive and control the vehicle before they will be allowed to race. This will be determined by the child going onto the track alone and making a short lap.

- 1) Drivers must be 18 years or older.
- 2) Drivers must wear hard hats or helmets that are **secured** to the head.
- 3) Drivers must wear long pants, and closed toe shoes.
- 4) ALL MOWERS MUST BE EQUIPPED WITH A GROUND KILL SWITCH THAT ATTACHES TO THE DRIVER
- 3) The Safety Committee at each race has the final say whether or not an entry may run.
- 4) Intentional "ramming" is grounds for disqualification and will be up to the Judge's discretion.
- 5) Contestant numbers are required and will be provided at time of inspection on day of the race. Must be clearly visible and placed on the front of the mower during the race.
- 6) Anyone jumping the starting flag will be sent to the back of the pack.
- 7) No alcohol allowed in the Pit Area.
- 8) Drivers must check in and waivers must be signed 1 hour and 15 minutes prior to the race
- 9) **HORSE RACE START**

MOWER ELIGIBILITY

- Events are open to all riding type lawn mowers and garden tractors up to maximum **17HP** that were mass-produced and commercially available to mow residential lawns. Zero-turn mowers are NOT permitted. The mower may be modified from its original configuration as noted in these rules for special classes only.
- Final determination of eligibility and classification is up to the race officials.
- Organizers reserve the right to reject at any time any mower, which in their opinion, represents an attempt to defeat the spirit of these rules, even though it may comply with the actual letter of the rules.
- Mowers will be allowed to compete in only one class.
- Drivers owning two machines prepared for the same class may race one machine in the heat and a second mower in the feature. Both machines must pass through technical inspection prior to the start of the day's racing action. If a driver utilizes their own back-up mower, that driver must start at the rear of the field. Drivers are not allowed to utilize someone else's mower to compete or complete a race.
